

2004 NCAA Final Four Security Policies

For the safety of all guests, the following security measures will be in effect during the 2004 NCAA Final Four.



“EXPRESS” ENTRANCES WILL BE DESIGNATED FOR PATRONS WHO ARE NOT CARRYING SMALL BAGS.

- No large bags (larger than 12” x 12”).
- No backpacks.
- Inspection of all bags will be required as you enter the Alamodome.
- No firearms, explosives, guns or knives or other weapons.
- All makeup must be in appropriate containers. No zip-lock bags containing any form of powder.
- No aerosol cans including mace and/or pepper spray.
- No bottles, cans, coolers or other containers except in cases of diaper bags or medical needs, as certified by a physician.
- No artificial noisemakers, inflatable noisemakers, air horns or megaphones may be used for distraction.
- No large signs, flags, banners or laser pointers.
- No video cameras are allowed on game days.
- No promotional items with commercial slogans or identification are allowed.
- No food or drinks may be brought into the facility.
- No in/out privileges.
- Small personal cameras with fixed lenses will be permitted, but no professional cameras.
- The facility has the authority to prohibit any other items deemed to be a security risk.
- Patrons will be required to return all prohibited items to their vehicles, hotel rooms or homes.
